

Motor Carrier/DOT# Reports and Alerts

ProfitStars® has implemented motor carrier and/or DOT number monitoring through an integration with Truckstop.com's SaferWatch™ Carrier Qualification and Monitoring service for validation of carriers by Motor Carrier and/or DOT numbers directly from FactorSoft. This interface also offers critical alert updating in the Monitor Alerts screen in FactorSoft.

When this enhancement is activated with ProfitStars® and in the FactorSoft control file, all of the Motor Carrier and DOT# information recorded in FactorSoft for clients, debtors, and carriers is exported to Safer-Watch for monitoring. In addition, critical information updates for monitored carriers are displayed on the Monitor Alerts screen for you to view.

Motor Carrier Monitoring Setup

Activation of Motor Carrier Monitoring requires a SaferWatch account. Please contact your Truckstop.com sales representative, and be sure to mention that you will be adding SaferWatch to your FactorSoft FactorSoft. Once your SaferWatch account is active, SaferWatch provides you with a unique Customer Key, which you then need to provide to ProfitStars® to complete the activation in FactorSoft. Please contact ProfitStars® at 205–972–8900, option 2 for further details.

Once activated, you will be provided with a SaferWatch Customer Key. The only FactorSoft set up requirement is entering your SaferWatch Customer Key in System Preference Identification/system constants, Interface parameters, SaferWatch Web Services, Customer key.



Set Up Motor Carrier Services

Service templates must be configured and tasks configured in the Engine to enable the communications for the Motor Carrier Monitoring communications.

The Motor Carrier Monitoring services are scheduled using the Schedule Task Processor option accessed from the Administration module's System menu. To schedule the service, create a name for the template in the **Service template** field, select the service (see below) on the Parameters tab, and save the template. Then, update the Scheduling tab to run the service at the desired intervals and save the template.

NOTE

For more information on the Scheduling tab, refer to the Reports Guide.

In addition, when defining SaferWatch templates, it is recommended that the SaferWatch Upload is scheduled to process at 2:00 PM, daily. It is recommended that the SaferWatch Alerts template is scheduled to process hourly, beginning at 8:00 AM.

The two services must be configured to enable the communication between FactorSoft and SaferWatch:

Service	Description
SaferWatch Upload	Sends motor carrier number information from FactorSoft to SaferWatch for monitoring of individual motor carrier numbers.
SaferWatch Alerts	Polls SaferWatch for critical alert updates and pulls them into the Monitor Alerts screen in FactorSoft.

Set Up Engine Tasks

Two Engine tasks must be enabled for Motor Carrier Monitoring:

- SaferWatch ContirbuteNew enables sharing of Motor Carrier and DOT# information held in FactorSoft with SaferWatch
- SaferWatch Alerts enables update of motor carrier/DOT# critical information alerts


Set Up Alert Triggers in SaferWatch

SaferWatch will provide concise daily alerts of changes that matter conveniently delivered via the Monitor Alerts screen in your FactorSoft. These built-in Alerts are automatic and have been pre-configured specifically for this interface.

To customize alert triggers from SaferWatch:



1. Login to the SaferWatch Dashboard using your account credentials.



2. Select the **Alerts** tab, then **Email Settings**.



3. From the section Where Do You Want To Receive Your Alerts?, edit your email list.

TIP

Since critical carrier information alerts are automatically returned to the Monitor Alerts screen in FactorSoft, you may find it redundant to receive these alerts in an email. You are able to control the email addresses to whom the alert emails are sent. Add or remove email addresses and click Update Email List.





4. SaferWatch will provide concise daily alerts of changes that matter conveniently delivered via the Monitor Alerts screen in your FactorSoft. These built-in Alerts are automatic and have been pre-configured specifically for this interface. The complete list of changes you may receive in your Alerts follows.

BIPD Required Amount, BIPD On File Amount, Cargo Required, Cargo On File, Bond Surety Required, Bond Surety On File

d. FMCSA Insurance Policy changes:

All Adds, Changes, or Cancellations

e. Company Fields:




Accessing the Motor Carrier Reports

Identity panel of the Debtor Information screen:




Identify panel of the Client Information screen:


